lists. One book per month. Grade level 2.8-4.0. Accelerated Reading Program also used. 10 Reading books by Abeka (first semester only).

We believe a child learns to read up to second grade and transitions to "Reads to Learn" beginning in the third grade. The first semester Abeka readers are used. The second semester chapter books from a Sonlight reading list and ACSI suggested reading is used as a resource.
